Mills Sproull Cup Rules:

- Group games are determined by a point system; 6 points-win, 3 point-tie, 0 points-loss; 1 point for each goal scored up to 3 in one game; 1 point for a shutout (max 10 pts per game).
- Tie breakers are in the following order: 1) Head to Head Competition 2) Goal difference 3) Coin toss. Each boys team will play 2 group games in first round to determine semifinal standings.

- In rare case of forfeit, it will be a 3-0 win for other team for max points. Coaches, please initial ref score card after each game.
- ***No GUEST players for tourney games, you can only play with your team.*** Minimum 5 players to play.
- Games will be 2-20 minute halves. Semis and finals will play overtime if necessary, 5-minute overtime Golden Goal, then penalty kicks, 3 shooters each team). If it is not a semifinal or final game, it can end in a tie on May 4
- All semifinal and final games must have a winner
There will be a short medal presentation after the final game for girls and boys on May 4. Have fun, pump your team up to the “tournament atmosphere” and call me with any questions.
